Rules

Amateur riders, are not allowed to earn money by training other riders or other people's horses. Simply put - you ride your own (or leased) horse for fun!

Youth riders, defined as individuals younger than 19 years old, are eligible to compete in youth classes until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 19. They may only ride a

horse that is owned by them, a direct family member, or leased to them through NRHA, NSBA, or APHA. AQHA provides an exception to this rule; however, caution is advised, as earning AQHA points could impact future amateur eligibility. This rule does not apply to Allbreed classes.

Allbreed Novice Nonpro, Riders who would be eligible for AQHA Level 1 are eligible for Allbreed Novice classes. Riders who are eligible for WRAN/WRAS D&C level and lower levels. A class with a slightly simpler pattern than the regular Non-Pro class.

Rules: AQHA Rulebook

Requirements: AQHA membership for riders and owners is required to compete in AQHA classes, together with an Affiliate membership. See www.nqha.no for an NQHA membership. The horse is registered in AQHA.

Awards: Ribbons for 1st-6th place, sponsored by NQHA.

Memberships should already be arranged upon arrival at the competition venue, but they can also be arranged on-site. Payments can then be made from your credit card directly to AQHA. You must be a member of NQHA or other affiliate membership to compete in a AQHA class, for example SQHA.

Exception: If you are only starting AQHA Halter Class, you are only required to have a AQHA membership, not affiliate as well.

Show Office, Administrative & Required Paperwork	
Show office	Opens no later than 19:00 on Wednesday, June 24th. Other times will be posted on-site and on social media. Only entries made on the official entry form are allowed. No text messages, Facebook, or chat messages are accepted. The secretariat is usually open until 1 hour after the last class of the day.
Important information	All paperwork: Registration papers, ownership, memberships (NSBA, AQHA, NRHA), ROM for Performance Halter (AQHA) must be in order with the secretariat before the first start! All horses must be properly identified and all relevant documentation (passport, registration papers, health documentation) must be available for inspection at any time during the event. Payment of invoice must be completed before receiving your startnumbers, and unloading your horse from the trailer. The class order may be changed based on the number of horses in accordance with the rulebook.

Show Management Reservations	<p>We reserve the right to cancel the show if it turns out that the show cannot be financially viable in advance. This decision will be made between the final registration date and no later than one week before the competition and will be announced on the website and social media. In case of cancellation, any fees paid will be refunded.</p> <p>The show management reserves the right to delay, modify or cancel classes or the entire event if weather, footing, temperature or other conditions may compromise horse welfare.</p> <p>If you are aiming to compete, please register on time! The opportunity to compete may be lost if you do not register on time!</p>

The horse must be at least three years old to be ridden within the competition area. A mare that has reached 7 months of pregnancy and/or has a foal at her side may not be ridden within the competition area.

Only horses deemed fit for competition may participate. Horses that are injured, sick, exhausted, heavily pregnant or nursing foals are not allowed to compete.

Inhumane treatment of horses within the competition area will result in disqualification from the competition.

All warm-up sessions will be monitored, and excessive use of spurs, bits, whips, or similar will result in a warning, followed by disqualification.

All fees paid will be forfeited and will not be refunded in cases of disqualification.

The competition management recommends helmets for youth riders when riding within the competition area.

Horse welfare

Regarding the welfare and well-being of the horses, the show management recommends that you choose your classes carefully, taking into account not to over-compete your horse. The show management will contact you and advise if we see it necessary.

The exhibitor/owner/rider is responsible for the horse's welfare, condition, documentation, and compliance with all applicable rules during the event. Make sure your horse always has water. The stalls are monitored frequently throughout the day.

These welfare rules apply throughout the competition grounds, including arenas, warm-up areas, stabling areas, and other areas used in connection with the show.

The show management, judge and/or Animal Welfare Officer reserve the right to prohibit a horse from competing or to remove a horse from the arena if welfare concerns arise.

First aid for horses will be available at the showgrounds at all times.

Doping tests

Doping tests may be conducted during the competition. Horses that have received veterinary treatment must comply with applicable withdrawal times. Horses under the influence of medication, substances, or treatment that may affect performance or welfare are not allowed to compete.

<p>Fair Play and Conduct</p>	<p>As the organizer, we place strong emphasis on good sportsmanship and respectful behavior – from participants, guardians, support personnel, and spectators alike. Unsportsmanlike conduct or behavior reflecting poor sportsmanship – whether directed at fellow competitors, officials, or horses – will not be tolerated.</p> <p>One (1) warning will be issued in the event of a violation. In the case of repeated offenses or serious breaches, we reserve the right to expel the participant(s) from the event without further compensation. We ask everyone to contribute to a safe, animal-friendly, inclusive, and positive environment throughout the competition.</p> <p>Concerns regarding a horse’s soundness or welfare must be reported immediately to the Steward, Gate, Show Office, or Animal Welfare Officer. The matter will then be handled in accordance with the official show procedures and applicable welfare regulations.</p> <p><u>No one else is permitted to approach or contact the judge directly.</u></p>
<p>Free riding</p>	<p>The indoor show arenas will be available for free riding during most breaks, as well as before and after the show, unless otherwise stated. Exhibitors must refer to posted arena information for any specific limitations.</p> <p>All horses <u>must</u> wear their assigned number at all times when in either arena.</p> <p>Exhibitors warming up for their upcoming class have priority in both arenas. This is dynamic and class-dependent, and priority applies to riders preparing to enter the arena.</p> <p>Failure to respect this priority may result in the show management or show team requesting the exhibitor to leave either the indoor or outdoor arena.</p> <p>Riders must immediately vacate the arena when the tractor enters to drag.</p>
