<b>Competition rules</b>			
<b>Paid warm up</b>	The purpose of PWU is to give the horses and riders the chance to get to know the competition arena.  Trail PWU – registration to PWU when registering or on site, time slots will be selectable/reserved closer to the competition via excel file. Pleasure and Hunter PWU are registered with registration or on site.		
<b>"Cross Enter"</b>	According to the rule books in each association, all breed according to the AQHA rule book.		
<b>All Breeds classes, general rules</b>	No membership is required to participate in all breeds classes. All breeds classes are judged according to the AQHA rulebook.

	<p>When it comes to bit rules, Level 1 rules are applied - which means that any approved bit can be used regardless of the horse's age.</p> <p>In HSE &amp; HSE, railwork is withdrawn!</p> <p>Ribbon to 1-6 placed. Below are class-specific rules for different levels of all breeds classes.</p>
<b>All Breed Open</b>	Open to all horses and riders/handlers regardless of skill level and rider status.
<p><b>All Breed</b></p>  <p><b>All breed Circuit Champion Walk&amp;Trot Walk&amp;Trot</b></p>	<p>A class where the patterns only include walk &amp; trot (jog). An opportunity to start <b>green horses</b> regardless of age without having to gallop.</p> <p>An opportunity for <b>Novice riders</b> to compete regardless of the horse's level of knowledge.</p> <p>Combinations that enter the corresponding classes with canter (All Breed, APHA, AQHA and NSBA) are not allowed to start W/T. Thus, the horse may be competed by another rider in gallop class, the rider may start another horse in gallop class.</p> <p>The purpose of W/T is to give combinations that cannot or do not want to gallop an opportunity to compete.</p> <p>The best combination in the allbreed walk &amp; trot classes will be rewarded with a nice trophy sponsored by NB Showhorses.</p>
<b>All breed Youth</b>	Classes open to all youth riders (up to and including the year the rider turned 19) regardless of breed of horse.
<b>All breed – Novice Nonpro (Trail and Showmanship only)</b>	<p>Riders who would be eligible for AQHA Level 1 1 / APHA Novice are eligible for All breed Novice classes. Riders who are eligible for WRAS D&amp;C level and lower levels.</p> <p>The Showoffice may ask you to present proof of your eligibility for the novice class.</p>
<p><b>Who's your Daddy showmanship</b> <i>Sponsored by Botarbo Gård</i></p> 	<p>Here we welcome these fantastic, hard-working fathers and partners who often stand behind our fine competing ladies and their horses!</p> <p>If you have a wife, partner or daughter with a horse who participates in Celebration, you can now go in and show your hidden talents in our Who's your daddy showmanship.</p> <p>In addition to a Mackmyra whiskey and SEK 3000 sponsored by Botarbo Gård, the first, second and third place will win a special Who's your daddy showmanship bow.</p> <p>The class is judged by two judges and their scores are added together to crown a winner.</p>
<b>Coollest Trailcup Yet</b> <i>Sponsored by Coolest Krymsun Yet, stallion of Kumlegaard.</i>	<p>Trailcup in 3 runs (Thursday, Friday and Saturday) during the weekend with added money of 10.000SEK. To qualify for the cup, the combination will ride a qualifying ride in the all breed open trail on Wednesday. To advance to the three cup runs, a score of at least 67 is required in the qualifying ride.</p> <p>The top five teams from the 2024 cup are directly qualified and do not need to ride a qualifying ride.</p>

	<p>Senior horses are ridden on a bit and one hand, junior horses any bit according to the rule book.</p> <p>Crossenter ranch trail and trail in the cup are allowed.</p> <p>Patterns for the trail cup are posted 1 hour before the start of the class. The classes are judged by two judges at the same time as they are rotated during the weekend and the total score is added together and all cup rides during the weekend to crown a cup winner.</p> <p>Participants must ride all 3 runs, in the event of a tie, a re-ride will be applied.</p> <p>The combination of horse and rider must be the same during all rides.</p> <p>Special cup bow and prize money for first-third placed.  1st place 6000 SEK  2nd place 2500 SEK  3rd place 1500 SEK</p>
<p><b>NSBA</b></p>	<p>NSBA classes require membership in NSBA Scandinavia <i>or</i> NSBA USA for riders <u>and</u> owners.</p> <p>Horses that start NSBA class must be registered in NSBA USA.</p> <p>Registration should be completed before the competition.</p> <p>Information about registration can be found on the website, <a href="http://Requirements for showing – National Snaffle Bit Association Scandinavia (nsba.se)"><u>Requirements for showing – National Snaffle Bit Association Scandinavia (nsba.se)</u></a></p> <p>The NSBA rulebook applies to all NSBA classes except for Trail in hand (APHA).</p>
<p><i>NSBA-S Younghorse cup</i></p> 	<p>Horses 2 – 3 years old are eligible to start in the Young Horse Cup. Rules for the Young Horse Cup, see specific document on nsba.se</p> <p>Horses competing in the younghorse cup are forbidden to be ridden at the competition site!</p> <p>Start in the Young Horse Cup requires NSBA-S membership for owners and participants.</p> <p>The Young Horse Cup is sponsored with a nice trophy by WPL Quarter &amp; Paint Horses.</p>
<p><i>NSBA Show Highpoint</i></p> 	<p>The highpoint title for the most winning horse/rider is awarded in the following categories.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• NSBA Open all around (The horse regardless of which rider is riding) Sponsored by JT Showhorses.</li> <li>• NSBA Youth all around (The rider regardless of which horse it rides) sponsored by NSBA USA</li> <li>• NSBA Amateur all around (The rider regardless of which horse it rides) sponsored by NSBA USA</li> </ul>

	<p>NSBA Young horse classes do not count towards the Highpoint title. Amateur and Youth riders earn their points in Non-pro classes.</p>
<p><b><i>Prizes, prize money, bows, and sponsored prizes in NSBA classes</i></b></p>	<p>The three judges' individual placements will be added together to form an "overall placement" in the class. Prize bows are awarded according to the overall result. Prize money is distributed according to the overall result. Points for high-point lists (Scandinavia and the United States' European list) are distributed per judge – i.e. three sets of points.</p> <p>55% of the class fee will be refunded as prize money to the account provided by the participant/horse owner, after the show. Added money in the class is added to the pot with the class fee and distributed according to the current table.</p> <p>In order for an NSBA class to be a Celebration class, it must have at least five entries who are members of NSBA Scandinavia, otherwise it will be considered a regular NSBA class.</p> <p>For Celebration classes: exclusive NSBA Celebration bows - Gold, Silver and Bronze will be awarded for 1-3 places. To be crowned NSBA Scandinavian Celebration Winner, NSBA-S membership is required!</p> <p>For NSBA classes without Celebration status, regular NSBA bows are awarded 1-3 placed.</p> <p>Only NSBA S members compete for the NSBA-S Year End Awards ranking. Only NSBA USA members compete for the NSBA USA Europe ranking.</p>
<p><b>IRHA</b> <b><i>Added money sponsored by</i></b></p> 	<p>The judges' individual placements are added together to form an overall result. Prize money and bow are awarded according to the judges' overall results. 75% of the class fee goes back prize money. Added money of 5000kr in each IRHA class. Membership in IRHA is required for riders and horse owners. International members are invited to membership in 2025 – become a member on IRHA's website - <a href="http://internationalrha.com">internationalrha.com</a> Prize money is awarded according to the NSBA payout schedule.</p>
<p><b>AQHA</b></p>	<p>Bows for 1-6 places. AQHA membership for riders and owners is required to show in AQHA classes. Ideally, memberships are already ready when you arrive at the competition site, but it can be arranged on site as well, payments are then made from your credit card directly to AQHA.</p>

<p><b>AQHA L1 Open/Nonpro Circuit Champion</b></p> 	<p>The best horse participating in the L1 Open classes (Green) will be rewarded with a Circuit champion title and receive a nice trophy sponsored by NB Showhorses.</p> <p>The best horse participating in the L1 Non-Pro classes (Green) will be rewarded with a Circuit champion title and receive a nice trophy sponsored by NB Showhorses.</p>
<p><b>AQHA Longeline &amp; Trail in hand</b></p>	<p>According to AQHA's rules, no yearlings are allowed to participate in the classes at this competition as it takes place before July 1.</p>
<p><b>APHA</b></p>	<p>Bows for 1-6 places.  APHA Rider and Owner membership is required for competitors in APHA classes.  Ideally, memberships are already ready when you come to compete, but it can be arranged on site as well, payments are then made from your credit card directly to APHA.</p>
<p><b>APHA Green Circuit Champion</b></p>	<p>The best horse participating in the Green classes will be rewarded with a Circuit champion title and receive a nice trophy sponsored by NB Showhorses.</p>
<p><b>APHA Chrome Cash</b></p>  <p><i>Sponsored by Living Large</i></p> 	<p>Chrome Cash classes offered in Hunter Under Saddle Open and Non-Pro. Chrome Cash classes will be kept concurrent with the respective NSBA class.</p> <p>The judges' overall results will be reported to the United States and constitute the final placement in the class.</p> <p>Chrome Cash will distribute a total of \$2000 in the two classes (\$1000/class).  Prize money is distributed according to the NSBA's payout schedule.</p>
<p><b>Pattern</b></p> 	<p>The ambition is for patterns to be available no later than 29/4. The Trail Cup is published 1 hour before the start of the class.</p> <p>All trail patterns are designed by Tim Kimura and come from his portfolio of patterns used on shows around the world. The pattern sponsor is CR Saddles.</p>
<p><b>Secretariat</b></p>	<p>Opens no later than 11.00 on Wednesday 28 May. Other times are posted on site and social media.  The Secretariat is usually open until 1 hour after the last class of the day.</p>

<b>Observe!</b>	Submitted notification is considered binding. Unpaid registration will be invoiced regardless of whether the horse comes to the start or not. Non-payment will be subject to the highest level of officecharge regardless of when the notification was submitted.																																
<b>Late registrations, changes and additions</b>	Late registration, changes and additions on site must be made in the system or on the registration form in the secretariat. Already registered horses can change and add classes up to 1 hour before the class to the higher level of class fee. If starting lists have been issued, late registrations in the class start first. The ambition is to have start lists published 2 hours before the start, for the first class of the day, lists will be published the night before. <u>Late registration, changes and additions to the first class of the day must be made the day before.</u> No registrations made on facebook, messenger, SMS will be accepted!																																
<b>Refunds &amp; Prize Money Payouts</b>	100% of the class fees (not entry fees) are refundable if a <u>veterinary or medical certificate issued before or on the same day</u> as the specified class is presented to the NSBA-S. Account numbers must be submitted to NSBA-S upon request after the competition. Submitted account information will be deleted after NSBA-S refunded/paid out money. For international marketing, prize money can be stated in dollars. Due to daily currency fluctuations, \$1 is equated to 10sec in payout. <i>Any profit tax is paid by the recipient of the prize money.</i>																																
<b>Backnumber</b>	The correct number must be visible when the horse is ridden or longed at the competition venue. If a backnumber not provided by NSBA-S is used, the backnumber used must be at least as large as the one provided. Numbers provided by NSBA-S must be returned to the secretariat. Unreturned number bib will be charged SEK 100.																																
<b>Scoring – cups (not the trail cup)</b>	In all cups and highpoints (not the trail cup) the following points table will be applied. For NSBA classes, the combined result in the class counts for points earned according to the table below. For other classes, the individual judge's placement counts. <table> <tr> <td>1. It is then okay to participate without a horse, but you as a rider must be dressed competitively.</p> <p>Pay attention to the instructions for the award ceremony and leave the arena quickly after the award ceremony has ended so that the next class can begin. <b>Do not stop at the gate!</b></p>
<b>Vaccination &amp; Horse Passport</b>	<p>All horses must be vaccinated according to the Swedish Equestrian Federation's recommendations. Vaccination cards must be presented upon request.</p> <p>The horse's passport must be able to be shown at the competition site.</p>
<b>Important information</b>	<p>All paperwork; Registration certificate, ownership, membership NSBA/AQHA/APHA, must be in order with the secretariat <b><u>before the first start!</u></b></p> <p>The competition organizer reserves the right to change the days of classes in cases where they are deemed necessary to regulate the length of the competition days.</p> <p>The class order may change based on the number of horses in accordance with the rulebook.</p> <p>AQHA Halter classes can be combined according to the rulebook to 2&amp;under and 3&amp;over.</p> <p>AQHA Junior and Senior classes can be combined into one AA class according to the rulebook.</p> <p>APHA Junior and Senior classes can be combined into an AA class according to the rulebook.</p> <p>Due to daily currency fluctuations, \$1 is equated with 10SEK in all cases when prize money is advertised in dollars, paid out and reported to the United States.</p>
<b>GDPR</b>	<p>Personal data submitted to the competition organization is processed and stored in order to be able to run the competition in accordance with the applicable requirements of the respective organization. Results are reported to the respective association in the USA and administered on the website.</p>
<b>Profit tax</b>	<p>Any profit tax on prize money is reported and paid by the recipient.</p>

<b>Ethics</b>	<p>The horse must be at least three years old to be ridden within the competition area.</p> <p>Mares that have reached 7 months of gestation and/or have foals on the side, may not be ridden within the competition area.</p> <p>Inhumane treatment of horses within the competition area will result in suspension from the competition.</p> <p>All riding will be monitored and excessive use of spurs, bits, rods or similar will carry a warning and then be suspended.</p> <p><u>All fees paid will be forfeited and will not be refunded in cases of rejection.</u></p> <p>The competition committee <i>recommends</i> helmets for youth riders when riding within the competition area.</p> <p>Doping tests may occur during the competition.</p>
<b>Horse welfare</b>	With the welfare and well-being of horses in mind, show management recommends that you choose your classes carefully regarding not over-competing your horse.
<b>Photographer</b>	<p>Official competition photographer Magnus Billberg is on site. Contact the photographer to view and purchasing images. <a href="https://billbergphotography.com/">https://billbergphotography.com/</a></p> <p>By your participation, you grant NSBA-S the right to photograph and use images of your participation in the show. 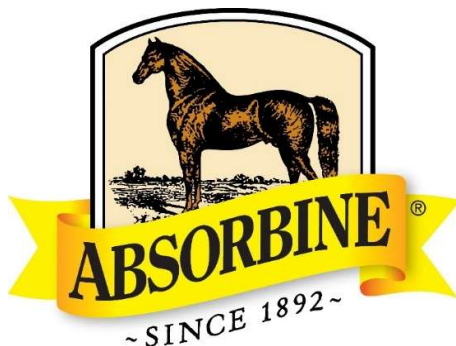
