Registration is made in the Equistration program online. Direct link is available on NSBA.se

You can register up until the day before your first class at the latest. You have a cheaper office charge if you have registered and paid for your submitted application in full no later than 29 April.

### *On-site payment solution*

Showoffice does not accept cash, only SWISH or bank transfers.

You will be asked to show proof of transfers made during the weekend.

### *Late registrations, changes and additions*

Late registration, changes and additions on-site must be made in the system or on the registration form in the showoffice.

Already registered horses can change and add classes up to 1 hour before the class starts. If start lists/draws have been issued, late entries will be first go in the class.

Late registration, changes and additions to the first class of the day must be made the day before.

No registrations made on facebook, messenger, SMS will be accepted!

The ambition is to have start lists published 2 hours before the start, for the first class of the day, lists will be published the night before.

All changes and/or additions made at the competition venue (27/5 or later) will be charged 50 SEK/occasion in office change fee, this includes all types of class/horse/rider changes. *For example, if you add three classes at one time, you will be charged 50 SEK in change fee, if you add three classes at three times, you will be charged 50 SEK per time =50\*3.*

### *Other information regarding submitted entry*

Submitted entry is considered binding. Unpaid entry will be invoiced regardless of whether the horse comes to the show or not. Non-payment will be subject to the highest level of office charge regardless of when the entry was submitted.

## Competition rules

All classes follow their own rulebook, in cases where deviations or regulations are not to be read in the rulebook, you can find these here.



### NSBA

NSBA classes require membership in NSBA Scandinavia or NSBA USA for riders and owners.

Horses that start NSBA class must be registered in NSBA USA.

Registration should be completed before the competition. Information about registration can be found on the website, Requirements for showing - National Snaffle Bit Association Scandinavia (nsba.se)

The NSBA rulebook applies to all NSBA classes except for Trail in hand (AQHA).

### Results, prize money, ribbons and sponsored prizes in NSBA classes

The two judges' individual placements will be added together to form an "overall placement" in the class.

Prizes and ribbons are awarded according to the overall result. Prize money is distributed according to the overall result.

Points for high-point lists (Scandinavia and the United States' European list) are distributed per judge - i.e. two sets of points.

Only NSBA S members compete for the NSBA-S Year End Awards ranking. Only NSBA USA members compete for the NSBA USA Europe ranking.

55% of the class fee will be refunded as prize money to the account provided by the participant/horse owner, after the show. Added money in the class is added to the purse with the classfee and distributed according to the current table.

For an NSBA class to be a Celebration class, it must have at least five starters who are members of NSBA Scandinavia, otherwise it will be considered a regular NSBA class.

Celebration classes: exclusive NSBA Celebration bows - Gold, Silver and Bronze will be awarded for 1-3 placements. **To be crowned NSBA Scandinavian Celebration Winner, NSBA-S membership is required!**

NSBA classes without Celebration status are awarded regular NSBA bows 1-3 placed.


*NSBA Amateur Select (50&Over)*

**NEWS!**

As a test 2026 year, we offer a limited number of NSBA Amateur 50&over. Whether the outcome will be evaluated is whether Select is something to continue with in the coming years. Select is for amateurs over 50 years old.

**NSBA Rulebook 45.** *A rider who starts Amateur Select on his horse A and can start his horse B in the non-age-regulated Nonpro class. The horse can be started by rider A in Select and rider B in non-age-regulated Nonpro.*

*NSBA-S Younghorse cup*



Horses 2 - 3 years old are eligible to start in the Young Horse Cup. Rules for the Young Horse Cup, see specific document on nsba.se

Horses competing in the younghorse cup are forbidden to be ridden at the competition site!

Start in the Young Horse Cup requires NSBA-S membership for owners and participants.

The Young Horse Cup is sponsored with a nice trophy by WPL Quarter & Paint Horses.

*NSBA Show Highpoint*

Several highpoint titles in NSBA classes will be awarded during the competition weekend. NSBA Young horse classes do not count towards the Highpoint title. Amateur and Youth riders earn their points in non-pro classes.

*NSBA Open all around*

The horse, regardless of which rider rides it in NSBA Open classes, earns the most points, wins a pair of Harris reins sponsored by NSBA USA. (Ranch classes do not count towards this highpoint.)

*NSBA Amateur all around*

The rider, regardless of which horse they ride in the various NSBA Nonpro classes, who earns the most points wins a pad bag sponsored by NSBA USA

*NSBA Amateur 50&over All around*

The rider who, regardless of which horse they ride in NSBA 50&over, has earned the most points wins a nice trophy sponsored by Botarbo Gård (NSBA Select Showmanship, Horsemanship and Pleasure)

*NSBA Youth all around*

The youth rider, regardless of which horse it rides in the various NSBA Nonpro classes, who earns the most points wins the NSBA Youth highpoint title. This title is open for sponsorship!

*NSBA Open (The rider regardless of which horse it is riding)*

The horse, regardless of which rider rides it in NSBA Open ranch classes, earns the most points wins the NSBA Open Ranch highpoint title. (Non-ranch classes do not count in this highpoint.) This title is open for sponsorship!

## All breed

No membership is required to participate in all breeds classes.

All breeds classes are judged according to the AQHA rulebook.

"Cross enter" - for entries in Allbreeds classes only, there is no crossenter restriction.

When it comes to bit rules, Level 1 rules are applied - which means that a snaffle bit can be used regardless of the horse's age.

In HSE & HSE, railwork is discontinued!

Ribbons to 1-6 placed.

Below are class-specific rules for different levels of all breeds classes.

### All Breed Open

Open to all horses and riders/handlers regardless of skill level and rider status.

### All breed Walk&Trot

A class where the patterns only include walk & trot (jog).

An opportunity to start green horses regardless of age without having to gallop. An opportunity for Novice riders to compete regardless of the horse's level of knowledge.



Combinations that enter the corresponding classes with canter (All Breed, APHA, AQHA and NSBA) are not allowed to start W/T. Thus, the horse may be competed by another rider in loping- class, the rider may start another horse in loping-class.

The purpose of W/T is to give combinations that cannot or do not want to lope an opportunity to compete.

The best combination in the all breed walk & trot classes will be rewarded with a nice trophy sponsored by NB Showhorses.

### All breed Youth

Classes open to all youth riders (up to and including the year the rider turned 19) regardless of breed of horse.

The best combination of the all-breed youth classes will be rewarded with a nice trophy sponsored by **WPL Quarter & Paint horses**



### All breed - Novice Nonpro (trail and showmanship only)

Riders who would be eligible for AQHA Level 1 / APHA Novice are eligible for All Breed Novice classes. Riders who are eligible for WRAS D&C level and lower levels.

The Showoffice may ask you to present proof of your eligibility for the novice class.

*Who's your Daddy showmanship*

Here we welcome these fantastic, hard-working fathers and partners who often stand behind our fine competing girls and ladies!

If you have a wife, partner or daughter with a horse who participates in Celebration, you can now go in and show your hidden talents in our Who's your daddy showmanship.

In addition to a Mackmyra whiskey and SEK 3000 sponsored by Botarbo Gård, the first, second and third place will win a special Who's your daddy showmanship ribbon.

The class is judged by two judges, and their scores are added together to crown a winner.

Once again, the class is sponsored by the initiator **Botarbo Gård**.

The class is also sponsored by MJ Showshirts.

To give new combinations the opportunity to compete, the winning exhibitor from the previous year is not eligible to participate.



## AQHA

Ribbons for 1-6 places.

AQHA membership for riders and owners is required to show in AQHA classes.

Ideally, memberships are already ready when you arrive at the competition site, but it can be arranged on site as well, payments are then made from your credit card directly to AQHA.

### *AQHA L1 Open and L1 Nonpro Circuit Champion*



The best horse participating in the L1 Open classes and the best rider in the L1 Non-Pro classes will be rewarded with a Circuit champion title and receive a nice trophy sponsored by NB Showhorses.

### *AQHA Longeline & Trail in hand*

According to AQHA's rules, no yearlings are allowed to participate in the Longeline and Trail in hand classes at this show as it takes place before July 1st.

## SQHA

Together with SQHA, we offer their championship classes and Futurity classes at Celebration this year. These are kept concurrent with the respective AQHA class.

### *SQHA – Championship classes*

To receive the title of SQHA Championship winner 2026 and medal, **the rider must** be a member of SQHA 2026.

The title of SQHA Championship winner 2026 and medal is awarded in the following categories

- Open junior
- Open senior
  - Open all ages - where junior / senior is not offered or merged
- Amateur
- Youth

A medal is awarded if at least 3 qualified combinations in the class.  
Medalists are selected by a tally of all judges' placements in the current class.

Medals are awarded as follows

3 entries - Gold

4 entries - Gold and Silver

5 entries - Gold, Silver and Bronze

### *SQHA Future Program (SQFP)*

Please see separate information on how to enroll your quarter horse to SQFP at [sqha.se](http://sqha.se)  
50% of the entry fee will be refunded as prize money as follows: This year's (2026) SQFP pot will be distributed to the winners after October 15.

The classes at Celebration 2026 are held concurrently with the respective AQHA Open class vg see showbill

SQHF is offered in the following classes;

- Halter (Stallions, gelding & mares) is offered for 1, 2-, 3-, 4- and 5-year-olds
- Trail in Hand and Longe Line is available for 2-3-year-olds
- Trail, Hunter under Saddle & Pleasure is offered for 4-5-year-olds
- Ranch Riding is offered for 4-5-year-olds

Ideally, memberships are already ready when you come to compete, but it can be arranged on site as well, payments are then made from your credit card directly to APHA. Results form the basis for the payment of PayntPoints from APHA.

The best horse participating in the Green classes will be rewarded with a Circuit champion title and receive a nice trophy sponsored by NB Showhorses.

### APHA Chrome Cash



APHA Chrome Cash classes offered in Hunter Under Saddle Open and Non-Pro. Chrome Cash classes will be kept concurrent with the respective NSBA class.

The judges' overall results will be reported to the United States and constitute the final placement in the class.

Chrome Cash will distribute a total of \$2000 in the two classes (\$1000/class). Prize money is distributed according to the NSBA payout schedule.



In all cups and highpoints, the following points table will be applied.

## Arena information

### *Free riding*

The show arena will be available for free riding during most breaks as well as before and after the competition days unless otherwise stated. See special information in the arena about any restrictions on this.

### *Showarena, indoors and outdoors*

We hope that the weather will be with us and that some classes will be able to be run on the outdoor track to streamline the competition days and thus save all the long competition days.

Otherwise, and if necessary, suitable classes can therefore be carried out in the old riding hall to prepare the large riding hall for the next class.

### *Warm-up and collect-ring*

Think about safety when you move around in the warm-up and collectring. There are many of us who share the space.

No hay is allowed in riding areas! But feel free to give your horse a snack from the snack bar sponsored by AQHA/APHA/NSBA judge and APHA Professional horse(wo)man Dora Gocze. The snack bar that is in warm-up area.

Please do not stay in the gate and collecting ring other than when you are notified by the gate staff. Stop and talk to your horse show friends, trainers and family, where you're out of showtraffic. It's for everyone's safety.

## Other information and rules of conduct

### *Paid warm up*

The purpose of PWU is to give the horses and riders the chance to get to know the show arena.

Trail PWU – registration to PWU when submitting entry or on site, time slots will be selectable/reserved closer to the competition via excel file. *PWU Trail on Wednesday can be ridden without a backnumber.* In cases where weather and other conditions allow, the PWU trail may also be held later in the weekend.

Pleasure and Hunter PWU are registered with registration or on site.

### *Back number*

The correct number must be visible when the horse is ridden or longed at the competition site (except for Wednesday's PWU). If a backnumber not provided by NSBA-S is used, the backnumber used must be at least as large as the one provided.

Number bibs provided by NSBA-S must be returned to the secretariat. Unreturned number bib will be charged SEK 100.

### *Code of Ethics*

The horse must be at least three years old to be ridden within the competition area. Mares that have reached 7 months of gestation and/or have foals on the side, may not be ridden within the competition area.

Inhumane treatment of horses within the competition area will result in suspension from the competition.

All riding will be monitored and excessive use of spurs, bits, rods or similar will carry a warning and then be suspended. All fees paid will be forfeited and will not be refunded in case of rejection.

Doping tests may occur during the competition.

### *Helmet*

The competition committee recommends helmets for youth riders when riding within the competition area.

### *Horse welfare*

With the welfare and well-being of horses in mind, show management recommends that you choose your classes carefully about not over-competing your horse.

### *Refunds & Prize Money Payouts*

100% of the class fees (not entry fees) will be refunded if a veterinary or medical certificate issued **before or on the same day** as the specified class is presented to NSBA-S.

Account numbers must be submitted to NSBA-S **no later than 30 days** after the last day of competition on the form provided. Submitted account information will be deleted after NSBA-S
